On behalf of Tlingit Homeland Energy Limited Partnership, we are excited to share some key updates to the Atlin Hydro Opportunity Project. This project will create clean, renewable energy for our community. We have been working hard to incorporate your feedback and to make the project safer, smarter, and more sustainable over the past year.

Recent Updates

In **February 2023**, we submitted our Clean Energy Development Plan (CEDP) to the Province of BC. We also hosted public open house events **in March** to share updates and hear your feedback. You can find more information on the CEDP and the open houses on our website. An engagement summary from these open houses will also be posted shortly.

About the Project

The Atlin Hydro Opportunity Project will generate 9.3 MW of clean energy in addition to the existing 2 MW that provides power to Atlin. Water stored in Surprise Lake will travel through a pipe and generate electricity in a new power plant as it passes through a hydroelectric turbine. The power we generate will travel to Jake's Corner and connect to the existing Yukon electricity grid. Water will continue to flow down Pine Creek to support ecosystems, current users, and Atlin's power production. The project will be TRTFN owned and operated. What We Have Heard

We have been listening to your feedback and concerns. We have updated the design to limit new disturbances, reduce impacts to beach areas, and conduct less in-water works. The updated design and construction methods will protect ungulates, shorebirds and waterfowl, fish and water quality, outdoor recreation, local and regional economy, and traditional uses.
